Literacy and Maths



All children in Neeld will access whole-school learning opportunities, including:

- Mastering Number *and* White Rose (*Maths*)
- Little Wandle Phonics (reading, writing and phonics)
- Literacy - **Helicopter Stories-Poetry Baskets**, with a seasonal focus on **Autumn poems** and "**All About Me**" to celebrate our individuality and strengths.



PE and Outdoor Learning



- **PE** day is Monday - please send your child in suitable kit (joggers, t-shirt, trainers).
- **Learning outside** will be on a Friday. Please provide wellies and send your child in suitable outdoor clothing such as joggers and jumper/sweatshirts to keep warm, including a coat. If possible, we would like to keep the wellies in school so as footwear does not get wet.

Daily Reminders:

- Each child needs a **water bottle** (let us know if this isn't appropriate).
- Please provide a **snack** (no sweets) and either a packed lunch or pre-ordered hot meal. We know mealtimes can sometimes be tricky, but we'll support children in building positive routines. Please **label all belongings**—uniform, coats, bags, bottles, and lunchboxes.

This half term, our class stories will be *Traction Man and Lost in the Toy Museum* which will support our exploration of toys in a creative way.
