Mrs Wilkins will continue teaching on Thursday mornings. We are also delighted to welcome a new Teaching Assistant to our team - Miss Surgey who will be working in Fox Talbot daily. We are very pleased to have her join us and are sure that everyone will help to make her feel warmly welcomed.

Our Learning This Term

Our topic continues to be **Creatures: Great and Small**, where children will learn about living things and their habitats through Science and Outdoor Learning.

In PSHE, we will focus on **Growing and Changing**, while Life Skills will explore **Community**, including staying safe and learning about people who help us.

We will continue with Helicopter Stories, Story Steps, seasonal texts, and learning animal and summer poems. Children will also continue to take part in **White Rose Maths** and **Little Wandle Phonics**.

- **PE:** Thursdays – please send children in suitable PE kit as we prepare for Sports Day and take part in team games.
- **Outdoor Learning:** Tuesdays – please ensure children have appropriate outdoor clothing, including wellies and a waterproof coat.
