What is the Patchwork Programme?

The Patchwork Programme is a **Free** and **Fun** creative 30-minute session for both parent / carer and their child to attend weekly. Each session has exciting activities that are centred around the child's like and interests.

The sessions are split into areas including, how we can practically support our children to practice regulating emotions, by creating a personalised 'toolbox' to help to facilitate calm. We also weave in the opportunity to strengthen a child's sense of self, whilst offering an opportunity to rebuild/ strengthen relations through fun sensory play.

These are all done in a creative and child-led approach, building on the skills they currently use and other creative ways to add to their 'Toolbox'.
