Changes to Household Support Fund

If your child is currently in receipt of free school meals you would have received a letter this week regarding upcoming changes. Support for Free School Meals in school holidays from the national government is ending. As a recipient of Free Schools Meals in term time, families would have received vouchers for food in school holidays. This was funded by the UK Government's Household Support Fund, but the government has now confirmed that this fund is ending on the 31 March 2026. This means that the holiday food vouchers that you have received will end after this date. However, you are eligible for a £5 voucher, per child, to cover the two days of the Easter holiday still covered by this fund.
